The complications should relate to both the operation and the indication if possible (criteria auditing). All deaths should be documented and discussed. If available, other data on key performance indicators and comparative data from other comparable hospitals would be appreciated.
- A hard copy of the audit should be made available for the audience, either at the time of the audit meeting or circulated to members of the Division prior to the meeting.
- It would be ideal if the unit head would encourage other participating staff to attend (apart from the unit members), to their unit audits. This may include ward, theatre and anaesthetic nursing staff, as well as staff from other departments such as physiotherapy, nutrition, etc. In addition, members of similar units from other Melbourne hospitals may be invited and encouraged to attend.

Thank you to all members of the Division who participated in the 2003 audits. It certainly increases our already heavy workload, but it is an essential part of our activities despite the scant resources and financial support available. All the effort and support shown over the year is certainly appreciated.
